The East Carolina University School of Dental Medicine Community Service Learning Centers operate in many locations across North Carolina. The purpose of these centers is two-fold: individuals who need dental care receive increased access to services and dental students receive clinical training. Services include cleanings, sealants, x-rays, extractions, fillings, crowns, bridges, dentures, and root canals. The community service learning centers target individuals living in rural and underserved areas of North Carolina.
