Program Overview

Lunder-Dineen is in the process of developing the MOTIVATE education program to improve oral health care. The MOTIVATE acronym stands for Maine's Oral Team-Based Initiative: Vital Access to Education. The goal is to improve the quality of oral health care and preserve the dignity and quality of life for older adults in long-term care settings in Maine. MOTIVATE provides a 21st-century, educational model that will expand oral health knowledge, skills, and practice for interprofessional healthcare providers in the long-term care setting. Led by a team of thought leaders and statewide stakeholders, the organization is conducting a needs assessment in collaboration with Maine Veterans' Homes, the pilot site for this program. Based on the assessment, Lunder-Dineen will work closely with the advisory team to develop a blended learning model to address the gaps in oral health education.
