



## Nemours SeniorCare Milford and Wilmington, Delaware

### **Program Overview**

Nemours SeniorCare, founded in 1981, is located in Milford and Wilmington, Delaware. The clinic offers medical services to low-income older adults, including vision, hearing, and dental services. Dental services include screenings, cleanings, x-rays, fillings, extractions, dentures, and root canals. Adults ages 65 or older who have low incomes (must meet income requirements) and live in Delaware are eligible to participate in this program. Since its inception, Nemours SeniorCare has treated thousands of Delaware's older adults for little or no cost. The clinic receives its funding from the Alfred I. duPont Testamentary Trust, which focuses on bringing medical care to older adults in Delaware.
